Pura Vida EcoRetreat Center is located in the unique coastal town of Yelapa, Mexico, where the friendly locals move around on foot, and with the help of boats and mules. There are no roads, no cars, no high-rise hotels, no banks, hospitals, or chains of any kind. Visiting this little village is like stepping back in time, in all the right ways.

Pura Vida's open-air palapas with panoramic ocean views from every bed, the organic, vegetarian, chef-prepared food, and the sea itself are therapy enough. The group activities and offerings are a bonus. And the magic generated by a circle of inspirational women completes the experience.



Each palapa sleeps 2-4 people, each with her own bed. There is one full bathroom with hot, running water per palapa, and you might even have an ocean view from the shower. Most palapas also have a hammock and a sitting/dining area with a view (you can't escape the view anywhere in this resort, which was built into the hillside at the point on the edge of town).



Three delicious and nutritious meals per day are served in this picturesque dining room.




Use your down time to relax in the saltwater infinity pool, walk to town, relax at the nearby beach, nap in your hammock, check out something from the library (which has a selection of books and movies on psychological and/or spiritual healing), enjoy a fresh fruit smoothie, or visit with your new friends.

What's Included:

- Your own bed in a shared ocean-view room or suite (private rooms are available for an additional \$400)
- Three fresh, organic meals per day, prepared by local chefs with professional training
- Daily housekeeping services
- A 60-minute integrative bodywork session with Hazel House's own Lisa Kammerud
- New Moon Ceremony for refreshing your dreams and desires
- Temazcal (indigenous sweat lodge) Ceremony led by a local shaman
- Intuitive art-making, with all supplies provided
